



TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, VARIOUS ROADS, CHAPEL GATE AREA, HURN, CHRISTCHURCH

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended as amended by the Road Traffic [Temporary Restrictions] Act 1991. The Order is required to facilitate Dorset County Council carrying out highway improvement works. The order will come into effect at 00.01hrs on the 01st July 2017, until 30th November 2017 at 23:59hrs, a period of 22 weeks days. But it will remain in force for 18 months and can be extended, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

The effect of this Order is as follows;

[A] To impose a temporary 30 mph speed limit upon, B3073, Parley Lane, Hurn [both sides of the carriageway] from Chapel Gate Roundabout to approximately outside 401, Parley Lane, Christchurch, a distance of approximately 380 metres.

[B] To impose a temporary 30 mph speed limit upon Chapel Gate, Hurn, [both sides of the carriageway] from Chapel Gate Roundabout to the junction with Chapel Lane, a distance of approximately 355 metres.

[C] To impose a temporary 30 mph speed limit upon B3073, Parley Lane, [both sides of the carriageway] from Chapel Gate Roundabout, to the junction with Parley Green Lane, a distance of approximately 535 metres.
